10am Saturday July 20,

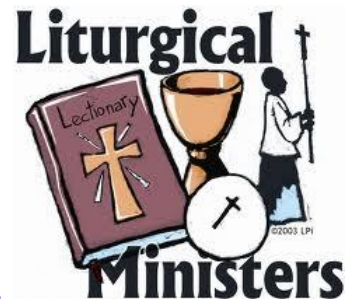
Repeated 7:30pm Wednesday 24 July
