Before making any decisions, any legal documents or decisions would have to be discussed with family members and if no family members are available, trusted loved ones. Our best interests, care and well-being, and that of our loved ones, should come first.

Information is included for: Enduring Guardian, Enduring Power of Attorney and Advanced Care Directive. Each are a legal binding document and should give us and those we love the confidence knowing that future care, well-being, finances and best interests are taken into consideration and acted upon.

There are numerous documents and information available. A solicitor can guide you with the process of Enduring Guardianship and Enduring Power of Attorney; your local GP can guide you about Advanced Care Directive; there are forms and information available on the government websites (information attached came from government sites). *Please pass this on to anyone you feel it could be helpful for.*
